Under Executive Order 57, if you already have an <u>existing client</u> relationship, you may continue to see that client via telehealth for as long as the Executive Order 51 (declaring the Covid State of Emergency) lasts. If, however, you would like to see new clients, located in Virginia, you will need to apply for Licensure by Endorsement at <u>https://www.dhp.virginia.gov/social/social forms.htm</u>. Instructions to apply are also on this website, as well as contact information should you have any questions about the application process.
